1. WHEREAS: The Stop Online Piracy Act failed utterly due to poor reflection of the interest of the

3. WHEREAS: Hart Research Associates have found 75% of respondents do not want any federal
4. internet regulations, and of the remainder, two-thirds wish the federal government to
5. focus on areas not already being addressed; and
6. WHEREAS: Anonymous, a group of extremely powerful hackers, has attacked the United States' own
7. websites, is currently opposed to any regulation, and will not attack if not backed by the
8. people; and
