

A Bill to Open Free Trade with the European Union

BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. The Federal Government of the United States of America will henceforth commence free trade with the European Union and its subsidiaries.

SECTION 2. Free Trade is defined as the following:

A system of trade between nations in which there are no special taxes placed on imports or exports.

The European Union and its subsidiaries are defined as the following:

Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, and the United Kingdom.

SECTION 3. Six months after the Bill is passed.

SECTION 4. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
