

A Resolution to Support the Educational Revolution to Increase Funding for Charter Schools

- WHEREAS,** The public school system is inadequate on its own to its stated purpose yet doesn't sufficiently fund its sister system the charter schools; and
- WHEREAS,** It funds students attending charter institutions at less than \$2 to \$3 spent on every student in the public system leaving the charter system starved; and
- WHEREAS,** This starvation prevents charter schools from hiring top quality teachers and providing top quality service to their students; and
- WHEREAS,** Charter schools represent an innovative avenue to providing targeted education to every student; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED,** That the Congress here assembled recommend that charter schools be funded to the same level as public schools.
